CYO eligibility Rules

Below, are the *Our Lady of Loretto* CYO eligibility Rules in order of priority. These rules are in effect for the 2015/2016 CYO Seasons.

	Category of Eligibility	Explanations
1.	OLL School	If a child is a student of the school, HE/SHE is eligible to participate in the OLL CYO programs.
1.	OLL School of Religion (CCD)	If a child participates in the OLL School of Religion (Spanish or English) program, HE/SHE is eligible to participate in the OLL CYO programs.
2.	Parish Members (Includes Members of St. Anthony's)	If a child's family live in the OLL Parish, yet they attend another Catholic Church, HE/SHE is eligible to participate in OLL CYO programs. <i>(with a letter from the pastor confirming the child is in the religious program)</i>
3.	Parish Boundaries and Enrolled in a Religious Education Program	If a child lives within the OLL parish boundaries, yet attends another denominational church, HE/SHE is eligible to participate in OLL CYO programs. <i>With a written request to the OLL Pastor from player's religious leader (Pastor, Rabbi, Reverend, etc...) confirming the child is enrolled in a Religious Education Program.</i>
